Goa River marathon, ready to run

The 14th edition of the SKF-Goa River Marathon (SKF-GRM) is set to take place on Sunday, December 8, starting and finishing at the Chicalim Panchayat grounds. Renowned as Goa's most popular marathon, the event will feature five categories: the full marathon (42 km), 20 miles (32 km), half marathon (21 km), 10 km, and 5 km.

Nitin Bandekar, president of Vasco Sports Club, the marathon's organizers, announced that they expect around 5,000 runners from across India and overseas to participate. Bandekar highlighted the event's theme, “Steps for All,” and its role in promoting long-distance

recreational running in Goa. He noted that 65% of participants typically come from outside Goa, with last year's event attracting athletes from all 28 Indian states and 21 foreign countries, contributing significantly to the local tourism sector.

The total prize pool for this year's marathon is set at Rs 8 lakhs. Mukund Vasudevan, Managing Director of SKF India, expressed pride in the continued sponsorship, emphasizing the shared values of resilience and the joy of sports. Rakesh Unny, Vasco Sports Club secretary, confirmed that the AIMS-approved route allows SKF-GRM finishers to qualify for major international marathons like London, Boston, New York, and Chicago.

We trained yesterday, we'll train today, and we'll be ready for tomorrow,” said the Spaniard.
