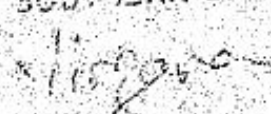

WHO director in Asia put on leave
LONDON: The World Health Organisation's top director in the Western Pacific, Dr. Takeshi Kasai, has been indefinitely removed from his post, according to internal correspondence obtained by The Associated Press. Kasai's removal comes months after an AP investigation revealed that dozens of staffers accused him of racist, abusive and unethical behaviour that undermined the UN agency's efforts to stop the coronavirus pandemic in Asia. WHO Director-General Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus told staff in the Western Pacific in an email on Friday that Kasai was "on leave" without elaborating further. **AP**

Heavy gunfire rocks Iraq's Green Zone
BAGHDAD: Supporters of an influential Iraqi Shiite cleric fired rocket-propelled grenades and machine guns into Iraq's Green Zone as security forces returned fire on Tuesday, seriously escalating a month-long political crisis gripping the nation. The death toll rose to at least 30 people after two days of unrest, officials said. **AP**

Philippines' dengue death toll reaches 400
MANILA: The Philippines' Department of Health said on Tuesday that deaths from dengue fever have climbed to 400 this year as cases rose by 143% from the same period last year. The Department has tallied 118,785 cases from January 1 to August 13, reports Xinhua news agency. Data showed the Central Luzon region recorded the highest, with over 21,000 cases, followed by Central Visayas and Metro Manila with over 11,000 each. Six of the country's 17 regions "have exceeded the epidemic threshold" in the past four weeks from July 17 to August 13, with Metro Manila "showing a sustained increasing trend". Dengue is endemic in the Philippines. **IANS**

Ukraine wages counterattack in its bid to reclaim Kherson

It claims to have inflicted heavy damage in the Russian-occupied south

Ukraine claimed to have destroyed bridges and ammunition depots and pounded command posts in a surge of fighting in the Russian-occupied south, fueling speculation on Tuesday that its long-awaited counteroffensive to try to turn the tide of war was underway. Russia said it repelled the attack and inflicted heavy casualties.

The clashes took place in the country's Kherson region, where Moscow's forces rolled up major gains early in the war.

Ukrainian authorities kept the world guessing about their intentions in the latest round of fighting and cautioned against excessive optimism in a conflict that has seen changing fortunes before.

While independent verification of battlefield action has been difficult, Britain's Defense Ministry said in an intelligence report that several Ukrainian brigades had stepped up their artillery fire in front-line sectors across southern Ukraine.

The port city of Kherson is an important economic hub close to the Black Sea and the first major city to fall to the Russians in the war that began six months ago.

Ukraine's presidential office reported that "powerful explosions continued during the day and night in the Kherson region. Tough battles are ongoing practically across all" of the area. Ukrainian forces, the office said, destroyed ammunition depots and all large bridges across the Dnieper River that are vital to bring supplies to Russian troops. The Ukrainian military

also reported destroying a pontoon bridge across the Dnieper that the Russian forces were setting up and hitting a dozen command posts in the region with artillery fire.

Russian state news agency Tass reported five explosions rocked Kherson on Tuesday morning — blasts most likely caused by air defense systems at work.

Amid the talk of a major counteroffensive, Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy said in his nightly video address on Monday that one "won't hear spe-

cifics from any truly responsible person" about Kyiv's intentions, "because this is war."

The British defence ministry said that the most of Russia's units around Kherson "are likely under-manned and are reliant upon fragile supply lines" while its forces there are undergoing a significant reorganization.

Russian Defence Ministry spokesman Lt. Gen. Igor Konashenkov maintained that its forces stood up well and that Ukraine lost hundreds of troops, tanks and other armored vehicles in Monday's action. His claim could not be independently verified.

Ukrainian independent military analyst Oleh Zh-danov told The Associated Press that "it will be possible to talk about the effectiveness of Ukrainian actions only after large cities are retaken."

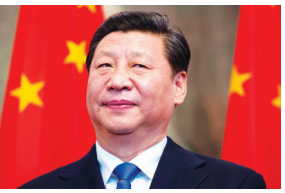
He added that Ukrainian forces had breached the first and the second lines of defence in the Kherson region several times in the past, "but it didn't bring about results."

Jinping set for third 5-year term China's Communist Party to hold key congress on Oct. 16

China's all-powerful President Xi Jinping is poised for an unprecedented third five-year term as the ruling Communist Party will hold a key Congress here on October 16, which is set to endorse his continuation in power for life, a privilege so far only bestowed on its founder leader Mao Zedong.

Except Xi, the key Congress comprising over 2,000 delegates from all over the country will endorse a brand new official team for the world's second largest economy as most of the top



Xi Jinping officials, including Premier Li Keqiang, who are in power for the past 10 years will either retire or get new positions at the congresses held every five years.

A Politburo meeting of the CPC which Xi, 69, presided over on Tuesday decided to hold the plen-ary meeting of the party on October 9 followed by the 20th Congress on October

16, according to an official announcement here.

The meeting stressed that the 20th CPC National Congress is of great significance to be convened at a crucial moment, as the whole Party and the entire nation embark on a new journey toward building a modern socialist country in all respects.

With the endorsement for the third term signifying his powerful hold on the party and the country, Xi was expected to attend the key international summits including the G20 to be held in Indonesia from November 15 to 16.

U.S. reports over 17,000 monkeypox cases

The U.S. has confirmed over 17,000 monkeypox cases, according to the latest data from the US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). A total of 17,432 known monkeypox cases had been reported nationwide as of Friday, Xinhua news agency reported, citing the CDC data.

New York had the most cases, with 3,124, followed by California with 3,291 and Florida with 1,739, according to CDC data. So far, the U.S. has the world's highest tally of monkeypox cases.

Musk filed more paperwork to terminate his agreement to buy Twitter, this time based on information in a whistleblower complaint filed by Twitter's former head of security. Twitter fired back by saying his attempt to back out



Elon Musk of the deal is "invalid and wrongful."

In an SEC filing, Musk said his legal team notified Twitter of "additional bases" for ending the deal on top of the ones given in the original termination notice issued in July. In a letter to Twitter Inc., which was included in the filing, Musk's advisors cited the whistleblower report by former executive Peiter

Rishi Sunak camp accuses Liz Truss of avoiding scrutiny

The Opposition also criticises her for pulling out of BBC interview

With just days to go before the polls close on Friday in the race to replace Boris Johnson as Conservative Party leader and British Prime Minister, former Chancellor Rishi Sunak's camp accused rival Liz Truss of avoiding scrutiny on Tuesday.

Foreign Secretary Truss, who is the current front-runner according to pre-poll surveys and bookie's odds, was due to face tough questions from veteran BBC

political journalist Nick Robinson in a one-on-one interview — already done by Sunak earlier this month. But the Cabinet minister pulled out of the interview

hours before it was to air on Tuesday evening, with her team saying she could no longer spare the time.

"Liz Truss has cancelled her BBC One interview with Nick Robinson which was due to air this Tuesday evening (30th August) at 7pm. Ms Truss' team say she can no longer spare the time to appear on 'Our Next Prime Minister,' the BBC said in a statement.

"The other candidate for the Conservative leadership, Rishi Sunak, was interviewed by Nick on

10th August. We regret that it has not been possible to do an in depth interview with both candidates despite having reached agreement to do so," it notes.

Robinson himself took to Twitter to say he was "disappointed & frustrated" at the cancellation.

"It's important that candidates face proper scrutiny so that [party] members and the public know what they are offering," an unnamed ally of Rishi Sunak was quoted by 'The Times' as saying.
