Promotions and structural changes discussed

The I-League 2023-24 is set to feature 13 clubs, subject to fulfilment of Club Licensing process. In a comprehensive virtual meeting, the AIFF League Committee addressed critical aspects of the league's structure and operations.

The league will adopt a home-and-away double round-robin format, totaling 156 matches for the season. Each participating club is scheduled to engage in 24 matches. The league champion will claim the I-League 2023-24 title and, contingent on meeting Club Licensing criteria, earn the opportunity for promotion to the ISL 2024-25.

The reigning champions, Punjab FC, have already secured their promotion to the ISL. To fill the vacancies left

by the relegated teams from the 2022-23 I-League season, namely Mumbai Kenkre FC and Sudeva Delhi FC, Delhi FC and Shillong Lajong FC, the top two sides from the 2022-23 Second Division League, have earned their place. Additionally, Inter Kashi and Namdhari FC have entered the I-League as corporate entries.

Chairperson Lalnghinglova Hmar highlighted the significant evolution of the league structure, connecting the ISL, I-League, Second Division, and Third Division, fostering a cohesive and robust hierarchy for football development.

Regarding foreign players, squads are permitted to register up to five foreigners, with a maximum of three allowed on the field simultaneously during I-League 2023-24 matches. The AFC player quota requirements have been eliminated.

The newly introduced 3rd Division League expanded its scope, with nine state Football Associations meeting the criteria to nominate teams. These states include Chhattisgarh, Delhi, Goa, Gujarat, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Punjab, Rajasthan, and Maharashtra.

Indian national men's futsal team will play their first international match today. The team, composed of 14 players selected from the Futsal Club Championship earlier this year, arrived in Bahrain on Thursday.

Led by head coach Joshua Vaz, India will compete against Bahrain in two friendly matches on August 12 and 14 at the Khalifa Sports City Hall in Bahrain, with the match starting at 8.30 p.m.

The matches are part of India's preparations for their debut in the AFC Futsal Asian Cup™ 2024 Qualifiers, which will take place in Dushanbe,

Tajikistan from October 7-11. India have been clubbed with Myanmar, Palestine and hosts Tajikistan in Group E.

Vaz and his boys are raring to go and create history tomorrow. "My first thoughts are those of excitement and hunger to go out there and represent our great nation in its first-ever futsal match. I'm sure my coaching staff and the boys are well prepared and have the same hunger for the match against Bahrain tomorrow," he said.

Bahrain are a mature side in the world of futsal, having first played in the AFC Futsal Championship in 2002. They also qualified for the previous two AFC Futsal Asian Cups in 2018 and 2022.

SAG clarifies policy for out-of-state players

The Sports Authority of Goa (SAG) has offered comprehensive clarity on the participation of out-of-state players from the Khelo India Centre of Excellence in Campal in badminton tournaments and national competitions. Responding to queries, Dr. Geeta Nagvenkar, the Executive Director of SAG, conveyed that such players are eligible to participate in State Ranking tournaments and represent Goa at the National level if selected.

This clarification followed the Government of Goa's decision to welcome out-of-state players at the Centre of Excellence. The move aimed at nurturing excellence and a competit-

ive spirit in sports, leading to discussions and inquiries from stakeholders, notably parents of local players. They raised concerns about these players' participation in state ranking tournaments and their eligibility for Nationals.

Dr. Nagvenkar's communication addressed the issue's queries and elucidated the rationale behind allowing the participation. She emphasized that the

players' inclusion adheres to competition guidelines and regulations, as well as the outcome of the February 23, 2023 meeting with Association members. The Centre of Excellence enrolled nine out-of-state players, adhering to transfer rules set by the National Federation (Badminton Association of India). These players have shifted their education and residency to Goa, making them eligible to compete in Goa State tournaments and represent the state.

Dr. Nagvenkar highlighted the Government's policy of fostering a competitive environment while promoting skills exchange, elevating badminton standards, and benefiting the sport. The policy aims to strike a balance between

nurturing local talent and attracting skilled players from other regions. It aligns with the primary objective of the Khelo India Centre of Excellence—to bring state players to national and international standards.

Acknowledging parents' concerns, Sandeep Heble, Secretary of the Goa Badminton Association (GBA), emphasized a balanced approach. He noted that healthy competition inspires local players, fostering excellence.

Top players have thrived against strong opponents in outstation academies, reinforcing the universal concept of skill elevation. Heble reassured that GBA is committed to maintaining a balance, ensuring ample local representation at Zonal and Nationals.
