India gears up for historic caste...

“For the conduct of the above census, there shall be an option for self-enumeration from August 17 to 31 just before the start of house-to-house population enumeration,” it said.

In the rest of the country, the population enumeration (PE) will begin next year.

This will be the first time when caste details will be collected as part of the census. The questionnaire is unlikely to carry a list of castes, and the responses will be recorded as shared by respondents, sources said.

The Congress on Friday attacked the government over the caste census issue, saying that not carrying a list of castes with responses recorded as shared by respondents raises “serious doubts on intent” and there had been no discussion with political parties.

Congress general secretary in-charge communications Jairam Ramesh said it had been widely expected that the caste question will be asked with a pre-prepared state-wise list as had been done in the Bihar and Telangana caste surveys with the response being just ticked appropriately.

The decision to include caste enumeration was taken by the cabinet committee on political affairs, chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi, on April 30 last year.

“In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 8 of the Census Act, 1948 (Act 37 of 1948), the Central Government hereby instructs and directs that the census officers may, within the limits of the local area for which they have been respectively appointed, ask all such questions of all persons residing within such

limits, subject to the items enumerated below, for collecting information through the Household Schedule in connection with the census of India 2027,” a notification from Registrar General of India said.

The respondents will be asked for personal details, such as marital status, age at marriage, spouse name, nationality, religion, scheduled caste (SC)/scheduled tribe (ST), caste, particulars of parents, disability, mother tongue, and other languages known, literacy, and digital literacy status, among others.

The biggest headcount of the world will be a totally digital enterprise.

Respondents will also be asked for attendance in an educational institution, highest educational level, stream, discipline, if they worked at any time during the last year, category

of economic activity, occupation, nature of industry, trade or service, class of worker and if engaged in non-economic activity (for marginal, semi-marginal and non-worker).

Whether they are available for work (for marginal, semi-marginal and non-worker) and if they travel to their place of work will also be part of the questionnaire.

The enumerators will also ask for the birthplace of respondents, place of last residence, reason for migration, duration of stay in this village/town since last migration, and permanent residential address, it said.

Currently married, widowed, divorced and separated women will be asked for the number of children surviving at present, the number of children in the current marriage, and the number of children born alive in the last one year.

Speaking during a programme at the police headquarters in the city, the Chief Minister said, “If someone is charging on them, it will not be tolerated. The police will not keep quiet. I have given them full power.”

The police’s duty is to protect people, he said, adding that anyone who charges at police personnel should be shown “what policing is”.

Sawant’s statement came on the heels of a confrontation between a police official and office-bearers of a political party in Sanguem. The police official was accused of assaulting a lawyer during the scuffle. An FIR has been filed by the Sanguem Police against the office-bearers of the party.

Health details of school students to be collected

Health parameters include height, weight and hemoglobin (Hb) count.

However, the limited time given to the students to come out with this data, especially the hemoglobin count, has put the parents in great difficulty.

The circular informs that the data will help the Union Ministry of Health and Family Welfare in strengthening digital health records of children through a unique health identifier and health cards.

“In the initial phase, the core focus is on generating, validating, and linking ABHA (Ayushman Bharat Health Account) IDs for all school-going children and linking their IDs with the Permanent Education Number (PEN ID) of the Ministry of Education,” the circular adds.

The schools have been instructed to urgently collect and submit student details and further told to ensure 100 per cent data completion and accuracy against physical verification records.

Furthermore, the consolidated data should be submitted to the respective block resource centres (BRCs) of Goa Samagra Shiksha, within seven days.

The students have to get their hemoglobin count checked through a blood test, and the state has an estimated 2.97 lakh school students enrolled across primary, elementary, secondary, and higher secondary levels in Goa according

to the recent UDISE+ school education data.

In addition, the week-long period given to the schools to collect the data includes two holidays namely Independence Day and a Sunday, when the blood testing centres/pathology labs are closed.

A number of parents have expressed their apprehension over the impractical timeframe, and the haste displayed by the Goa Samagra Shiksha in collecting the said medical data.

“Expecting parents to arrange and bear the cost of medical test at clinic or pathology lab is also absurd, besides not all parents having immediate access to such facilities,” many of the parents have maintained.

According to a parent, the RBSK 2.0 guidelines states that schoolchildren of the age group between 6 and 18 years are to be screened by mobile health teams for deficiencies, diseases, and developmental delays including disability, at the respective schools, at least once a year.

However, the government has now shifted the blood testing responsibility on to the parents.

A highly placed official of the Education Department said the programme is a central government’s initiative and as per the instruction of the Union Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, the data needs to be collected within one week, for forwarding to the directorate of health services, for needful action.

SC quashes FIRs against comedian Raina, 4 others

Besides Raina, the apex court quashed the FIRs and criminal proceedings against Vipul Goyal, Balraj Paramjeet Singh Ghai, Sonali Thakkar and Nishant Jagdish Tanwar.

The top court appreciated the efforts made by them in organising a chess tournament in March for specially-abled persons and helping raise awareness about organisations working for persons with disabilities, including the ones supporting those suffering from rare diseases such as spinal muscular atrophy (SMA).

“Once there are genuine

efforts, positive results are bound to be there,” a bench of Chief Justice Surya Kant and Justices Joymalya Bagchi and V Mohana said.

“They are very bright youngsters. If they have started working in the positive direction, they will bring positive results,” the bench observed. The top court was hearing pleas, including the one filed by M/s SMA Cure Foundation which works for individuals affected by rare SMA disease. The plea filed by the foundation flagged jokes made by ‘India’s Got Latent’ host Raina and other social media influencers Goyal, Ghai, Thakkar and Tanwar. **PTI**
